MEETING MINUTES

Ms. Crawford, chair of the school community council, called the meeting to order.

SCHOOL COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEMBERS/

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School Land Trust – Ms. Susuico

- Goal #1 Grades 4-6 will increase proficiency by at least 5% from the pre to post on District Benchmark assessments in ELA and Math.
- Goal #2 Kindergarten to 3rd grade will increase Acadience proficiency by 5% from the number of students who were proficient in the midyear assessment in 2019.
- In our plan, we were planning on using money for assistants. Many of our assistants decided not to return.
- Paying for .75 of 20% for a BTS Dance teacher, which students are loving.
- Paying for a Second Steps assistant to implement the program, which students are loving as well.

Students can come dressed in costume, but will still need to wear a face mask. We wouldn't have Cub Moms doing activities in the classes, it would be for the teacher to do. Feedback from the teachers is that they are comfortable having their own party.
