4. Safe Walking Routes - Price

- Price discussed routes. We looked at maps on Mountain Shadows website. Looked at crossing guards (4 crossing places)
- Reviewed loading and unloading access zones.
- Jess: Mentioned street J walking as a concern on the street across from the field
- Amy: sees both times, Kids goofing off in the street. Riding bikes in the street because of parked cars they are having to go in the road.
- Nicole: Sees both times as well

- EOY assessment.

39.5 Language Arts up by 11%

26.5 Math up by 1-2%

- Lots of work on LA, now to do math focus.

Team Leaders meet every month to discuss and problem solve.

2 district coaches helping in math.

- Mountain Shadows is TOP school to make growth in Language Arts.
- Mountain Shadows Report card: developing range, growth is exemplary
- Last year: started Walk to Read. (Intervention program and all grades, 6 week cycle)
- Make similar intervention for math - a way to find the holes.

Language Arts 69.9% Math 60.3% Science 59.3%
Growth lowest: 61.2%

- Science:

Nicole: Some teachers haven't started teaching science.

Susan: depends on grade. Some teach them together and some teach separately in the year. Teachers only have 30 minutes a day to teach this content.

- Focus: ELL State targeted school for our ELLs. ELLs are assessed every year.

Jess: speaking opportunity concerns. More worksheets and computer time and less interactions with each other since COVID.

Susan: teachers are tracking data of MLs

The school has a speaking focus (goal).

- Marinda: How to science grow? 6% - no goal for science but TSSA growth goal is 5%.
- Takes time to build proficiency
- Admin is asking for math specialist from district

- Office has referral data. (time of day, grade, behavior)
- Character Trait Assembly
- Teachers pick 1 student that exemplifies that trait. They get Cake with a Cop.
- Assemblies are super fun for the students. Teachers and students are involved for minute to win it games.
- Jess: Some teachers do not give tickets and it is upsetting for kids. (6th grade for her son was hard on this day)
- The tickets are tracked and recorded to win which grade gives/gets the most.
- Students sorted into Houses next year. There is an app. They want to get a tv tracker for students to watch their progress.
